



Coordinated Career Pathways (CCP) is designed for individuals to

achieve their career goals! CCP services are designed to meet each person's specific needs and work goals. Because CCP services are customized to the individual, all CCP services are offered 1:1 and provided face-to-face. Through CCP, two new services are available: *Career Pathway Navigator* and *Customized Employment Specialist*.

The Career Pathway Navigator (CPN) is essential for any client involved in CCP. The CPN assists in creating a Person-Centered Career Plan (PCCP), which can focus on employment but is not limited to it. This service also benefits clients who want to apply to college or university, attend trade school, obtain a certification, or learn a specific skill set. It's also a great option for those interested in starting a small business or working in self-employment.

The Customized Employment Specialist (CES) service is available to all CCP participants who are interested in employment, though it is not mandatory. This service specifically supports individuals in finding jobs that match their unique skills and goals.

HOURS

CCP Services are part of person-centered planning and as a result are part of the IPP process. Participation hours are determined through a Planning Team discussion. Requests for hours are then reviewed and approved on a case-by-case basis by the SDRC CCP Review Team.

ELIGIBILITY

There is no age requirement to be eligible to participate in CCP Services. Individuals may qualify if they are within two years of exiting high school or a transition program such as post-secondary education. Individuals may also qualify if they are within five years of leaving a sub-minimum wage employment setting.

DURATION

CCP is a time-limited service lasting up to 18 months.
Participation in CCP services may be extended up to 24 months depending on individual needs and on a case-by-case basis.
